Notice of Discipline Committee Decision

Concerning the complaint 2023-6

Decision on Remedy and Order

- The Discipline Committee(the Committee) considered the documents, materials and evidence submitted, including the oral submissions made by the Member's legal counsel.
- The Committee considered sections 37(8), 37(8.1) and 48 of the *Dental Act* respecting orders that could be made by the Committee.
- After considering all of the foregoing, the Committee finds that the conduct of the Member in respect of a patient was unprofessional and is deserving of sanction.
- After considering all of the foregoing factors, the whole of the evidence and submissions received and the findings made,

the Committee HEREBY ORDERS THAT:

1. the Member is hereby reprimanded for her conduct;
2. the reprimand shall be recorded in the registration records of the Member for a period of one year;
3. the Member shall, within 120 days of the date of this Order, at her own expense, complete a course on communicating with clients/social media use, or a comparable professional ethics course and that course shall be approved in advance by the Registrar of the Society;
4. the Member shall, within 120 days of the date of this Order, pay to the Society a portion of the costs respecting the Complaint in the amount of \$500;
5. if the Member fails to complete the course as referred to in subsection 3 or pay the costs referred to in subsection 4 within 120 days of the date of this Order, her registration and licence to practice shall automatically be suspended until such course is completed and such costs are paid in full; and
6. a notice with a summary of the Committee's Decision and Order shall be published in the Society's newsletter without the Member's name.
